



Office of Head Start Releases Birth-to-Five Funding Announcements

The Office of Head Start is offering applicants the opportunity to apply for funding to serve children from birth to age 5 and pregnant women, in the following service areas:

- Baltimore, Maryland
- Detroit, Michigan
- Jersey City, New Jersey
- Sunflower County, Mississippi
- Communities in Washington, DC

Through this funding opportunity announcement, interested applicants have an opportunity to consider proposing a comprehensive, seamless birth-to-five Head Start and Early Head Start program, including services for expectant families. Applicants are strongly encouraged to bring new and innovative ideas that are evidence-based or evidence-informed to maximize the extent to which Early Head Start and Head Start, in collaboration with other partners and early childhood education providers, can prepare children and their families for school.

Any applicant responding to this funding opportunity announcement will submit one application, whether the applicant is proposing to provide 1) Head Start services only, 2) Early Head Start services only, or 3) both Head Start and Early Head Start services.
