David Pickett: Hi, I'm David Pickett, and I have -- have had two girls go through the program, Julianna and Mackenzie -- through the TLC program, the Learning Center for Families out of St. George, Utah. And the -- the -- the program has helped a lot with my two girls. With Julianne -- both Mackenzie -- both have the same problem to where they were slow developing as far as their verbal and their motor skills and -- in everything. And -- and with the -- the Learning Center for Families, we have had a consultant come by and a -- and a occupational therapist come by and help -- help my girls with their fine motor skills and their -- their speech.

And, you know, with -- with that, Julianne -- now you can't keep -- keep her quiet. And she -- she loves to talk and she -- she's very energetic and -- and she is more outgoing and very personable with other kids. She interacts with children a lot better now since she's gone through the program, and the same with my youngest daughter, Mackenzie. She is starting to speak more and interacting a lot better with other people.

And, you know, with -- with me watching my girls progress through the program, it's -- it's changed a lot between me and my wife. We -- we're just so proud to see how well they're developing. And watching how they interact with other people is -- it's just really a great experience watching them progress and develop more skills and becoming better in -- in life.

That -- there's a lot of information out there to -- and a lot of people out there wanting and willing to help. All you have to do is go out there and try to find it and find all the information you can. And there's -- there's a lot of people out there that's helped us with our girls and I know they'll do the same for just anyone else, no matter what the situation or circumstances are. They will -- the program does work.

It -- it's taught me a lot about just how happy I just -- it made me feel more close and personal with my two girls and my family. And professionally, it's just made me a lot happier knowing that everything's going to be fine and that they're developing fine. And -- and -- and with all that stress off my shoulder, that they're not -- that they're not struggling, it just makes my -- it just makes work go by easier and smoother.

I'm just -- I'm just a parent that goes to the parent meetings once a month and -- and takes an active role in whatever I can do.
