Narrator: OpenDoors can be your own customized home-based tool, Sign in to OpenDoors using the same login information you use for the ECLKC to customize OpenDoors for you. Located at the very top in OpenDoors are four home-visiting handbooks -- the "Home Visitor's Handbook," a "Parent's Guide" to the home-based option, "Program Administrator's Checklist," and the supervisor's handbook.

Both the home visitor's and the supervisor's handbooks are interactive. It's interactive, meaning you can browse chapters, highlight things to remember, and take your own notes. The interactive handbooks also have video clips to accompany almost every chapter. These sections are called "Experience It." Bookmark your progress in the interactive handbook, so you can come back to the same spot later.

Finding other resources can be customized to fit your needs and busy schedule. Choose "Get recommendations," filter resources by beginner, intermediate, or advanced level, the amount of time you have, and whether you prefer to read, watch, or listen. Then, choose a topic and click "Show Recommendations." The tool will list recommendations, based on your filters. Pick up wherever you left off, every time you sign in to OpenDoors.

Sign in first using your ECLKC login information. Go to "My Library." Here, you'll find your favorites, bookmarks, highlights, and notes. Log in to the ECLKC and start customizing OpenDoors for you.
