The NCQTL House is a framework for effective everyday practice. You can click on each piece of the House, and it will take you to the information and resources that support that area. The foundation is about engaging interactions and environments. There are two pillars: one for assessment and one for curriculum. The roof is about individualized instruction.

15-minute in-service suites are located in different parts of the house. They are designed so a teacher can watch the overview video, download the tips for teachers, and try that technique in the classroom. You can also download a longer version with supplemental materials that can be used for training.
