PRESENTATION

This PowerPoint presentation ***Language Modeling and Conversations: Asking Questions, Birth to Five*** introduces a teaching practice to maximize children's learning by asking questions and extending conversations. The presentation includes visual and video examples that illustrate how asking meaningful questions enhances conversations with infants, toddlers, and preschool children.

Note: This suite is intended for a birth to five, center-based audience.
