- Q:** People want to know how they can get more information on the curricula, maybe where you're publishing this paper? I assume the citations for all these curricula will be in there.
- A:** We published this paper in *Infants and Young Children*, in the March 2014 issue. I can provide a reference for the paper as well, when we publish these slides.
- Q:** When you talked about training that was required for some of the curriculum, what does that mean?
- A:** They varied. Some of the programs had an online training that you could sign up for and attend, but some of them required you to physically go to where a training was being held. Some of the curricula had been widespread enough that they hold trainings across the country. But when there was training required, it typically meant you had to go physically to a place and be trained.
- Q:** Okay, so modest cost associated with that, then, also.
- A:** Absolutely. It was mostly the parenting interventions in curricula that required a training.



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
