The AIAN Language and Culture Community is part of the social networking platform referred to as “My Peers” and is sponsored by Office of Head Start for our grantees.

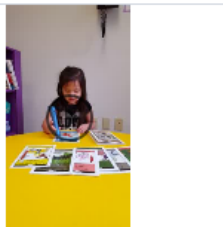
